Rules and Regulations

- It is strongly recommended that all riders take a moment to review the Rules and Regulation Booklet. They are available at the show and on the horse show website.
- To compete for year end awards, riders must be members, but do not have to be a member to compete for the day awards
- A negative Coggins test within 1 year is required and WILL be checked at Registration.
- Formal attire is not required but appropriate riding apparel is required. Shoes with heel, pants (no shorts) and shirt with at least a 4" sleeve.
- Safety helmets are strongly encouraged in any class but are required in on all riders age13 and under when mounted.
- All Divisions are based on the one horse / one competitor rule this year. Points will not be combined.
- Action devices will not be permitted.
- OPEN states that class is open to all age divisions

- Pee Wee: 8 and Under
 - Junior: 9 – 13
 - Senior: 14 – 18
 - Adult: 19 and Over
- All ages are as of January 1st of the Current Show Year

Catalog Race

Class is judged on speed

Rider is given a page number

Rider to go to the end of the arena, dismount and tear page with page number that was given to them out of catalog

Remount, and then ride to finish with page

Penalty for returning with wrong page.

Apple Race

Class is judged on speed

Rider to go to the end of the arena, dismount and feed horse a slice of apple/treat

Rider is not to remount; rider is to run along with horse back to finish

Arena Race

Class is judged on speed

Rider to go the end of the arena, around barrel and ride to finish

Penalty for knocking over barrel

Potato Race

Class is judged on speed

Rider to ride to barrel at the end of the arena, pick up a potato, ride to second barrel, drop potato into bucket

Penalty for missing bucket or knocking over barrel

Flag Race

Class is judged on speed

Rider to ride in with flag/baton to first barrel, put flag/baton into bucket, ride to second barrel and pick up flag/baton, ride to finish

Penalty for missing bucket, not picking up flag or knocking over barrel

Texas Barrels

Class is judged on speed

Rider to weave in and out of barrels set up in a straight line

Penalty for knocking over barrel

Barrel Race

Class is judged on speed

Riders to perform the clover leaf barrel pattern

Penalty for knocking over barrel or breaking pattern

Pole Bending

Class is judged on speed

Riders to ride to end of arena weave down and back up a line of poles, ride to finish

Penalty for knocking over pole
